Re: Audit of the joint Placement Report of the 2012-14 Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM), Post Graduate Diploma in Management (Marketing), Post Graduate Diploma in Management (Finance) and Post Graduate Diploma in Management (Human Resources)

We have audited the Placement Report prepared by you on the final placement of students of the 2012-14 batch of the PGDM, PGDM (Marketing), PGDM (Finance) and PGDM (Human Resources) programme of MIT School of Business, Pune (MITSOB). The Placement Report is the responsibility of MITSOB. Our responsibility is to validate the information provided in the report with the relevant documentation, and comment on the Placement Report's conformance with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards (IPRS) version 2.1.

In this context, we confirm the following:

- 1. For the purpose of the audit, we have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief, were necessary. In our opinion, the Placement Report complies with the IPRS version 2.1.
- 2. The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by MITSOB from recruiting companies and students. CRISIL has not independently sourced any information or documentation.
- We have verified the information with respect to remuneration, job function and location presented in the report
 with communication received from recruiters. Information regarding compensation received from individual
 students has not been used.
 - a. Where offer letters or other recruiter communication was not available, the report considers the record as 'Data not available'. We have not been able to verify the status of such students as there is no record.
 - b. The information has been categorised as best as possible under different salary heads as given in the IPRS version 2.1; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum earning potential'.
- 4. CRISIL has not been able to verify through any documentation the following:
 - a. The 68 students in the batch who graduated and did not seek placements from the institute
 - b. The 21 students who did not graduate (Six of whom were placed and considered in the placement report since as per declaration by institute, MITSOB follows a system where students can continue with their placements while completing backlogs, if companies where students are placed do not have objection)
 - No documentation was available for 27 students (including four students placed off campus, as per email declaration from the institute) from the batch
 - d. Acceptance of offer for 101 students could not be verified
 - e. Pre-placement offer for one student could not be verified

MITSOB does not maintain a formal process for recording above information.

CRISIL has not been able to verify that all placement offers were made through on-campus placement process.
 However, MITSOB has submitted, by email, a declaration stating that all placements considered for calculations in the report were through campus or supported by campus.
