Dear Sir,

We have audited the placement report prepared by FLAME School of Business (FSB), Pune, for the final placements of students of the 2011-13 batch of the PGDM programme. The placement report is the responsibility of FSB. CRISIL's responsibility is to validate the information provided in the report with the relevant documentation, and comment on the placement report's conformance with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards (IPRS) version 2.1.

In this context, CRISIL confirms the following:

- 1. For the purpose of the audit, CRISIL has obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary. In our opinion, the placement report complies with the IPRS version 2.1.
- The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by FSB from students and recruiting companies. CRISIL has not independently sourced any information or documentation.
- CRISIL has verified the information with respect to remuneration presented in the report with communication received from recruiters. Information regarding compensation from individual students has not been used. Data regarding location and function has been verified with communication from recruiters as well as students.
  - a. Where details were not available through offer letters or other recruiter communication, the report considers the record as 'to be decided'.
  - b. The information has been categorised as best as possible under different salary heads as given in the IPRS version 2.1; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'maximum earning potential'.
  - c. In one case, a student had two offers: we verified the offer accepted through email communication from the student.
  - Information regarding function of five students and location of four students has been verified with communication from these students from their corporate email IDs.
- 4. The number of students opting out of the placement process has been established through written/email communication from the students who have opted out.
